

The purchase of the DaVinci is fully funded by the Foundation.

First Robotic Procedures Performed at CHSB!

On March 13, Dr. Avinash Chenam, Robotic Surgery Medical Director, performed the first-ever robotic procedure, a prostatectomy, at Community Hospital.

One month later, on April 20, Dr. Bharti Jain, Vice Chair of Surgery, performed the first-ever general robotic surgery, a cholecystectomy. And, on April 27, Dr. Amir Azar, Surgical Oncologist, performed a hemicolectomy, the first-ever robotic colon resection at CHSB.

Congratulations to this team for these first-of-its-kind accomplishments at Community Hospital!








Women of Dignity Health-Inland Empire closed out the Reign Hockey season at the Toyota Arena, April 14th


